Scan and Verify

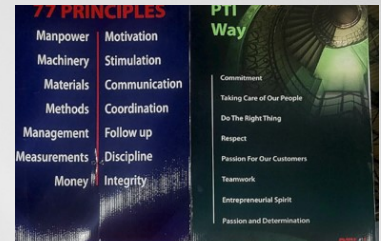

This system ensures that the serial number on the part and the part number on the bin's Plex label for are scanned and verified to match. This will prevent labeling errors. The initiative was led by our Quality Manager, Hashim Naqvi and was made possible through the partnership with Neapco IT, who provided access to their database via a secure VPN tunnel, and the PTI IT who, worked closely with Neapco to successfully execute this project.

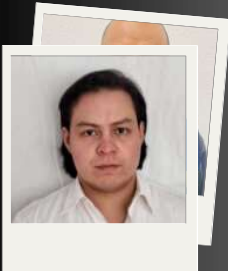
Associates participate in National Earthquake Drill

With a response time of 2 minutes, the workers orderly evacuated to the designated meeting point located in the parking lot, to safeguard their well-being in the event of a hypothetical 7.5 magnitude earthquake with an epicenter in Acapulco, Guerrero, and felt in the central region of the country.
