## New E- Locker masking

Last year, we experienced 19 axle failures due to E-Locker breakages, resulting in significant financial losses. Determined to address this costly issue, we conducted an 8D Corrective Action and formed a dedicated team to find a lasting solution.

Under the leadership of 1st Shift Production Supervisor Jason Adams, the team worked diligently to develop an initial trial masking. While the first version had some errors, the team quickly identified and resolved them, leading to the successful implementation of the official in-use masking we have today. Their hard work and commitment have played a crucial role in preventing further losses and improving our process efficiency.

## Screen washing container team

Here at Sterling Heights, we have recently adopted a new process introduced to us by Jeffersonville. This improved method allows us to optimize our workforce by freeing up employees for other essential tasks, such as cleaning the tanks. Additionally, it enhances our environmental responsibility by preventing chemicals from entering drains and the sewer system.

The process begins by removing the screens from one for the tanks. These screens are then transferred to the wash container for thorough cleaning. After being washed, they are moved to the rinse container for a final rinse. Once the cleaning process is complete, the screens are returned to the tanks, ensuring a more efficient and environmentally friendly operation.

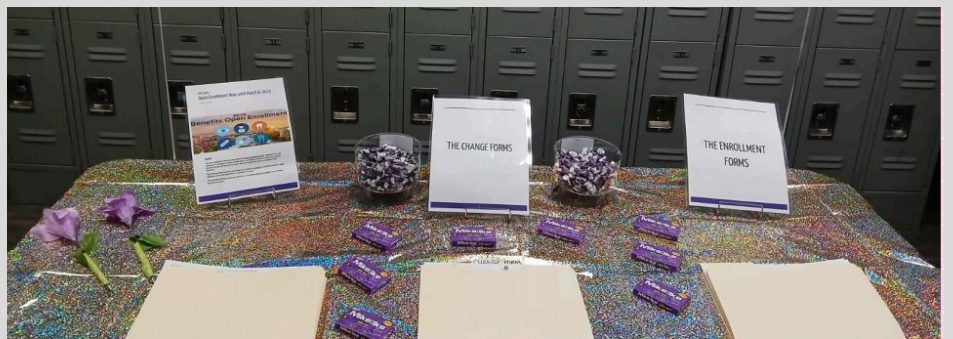

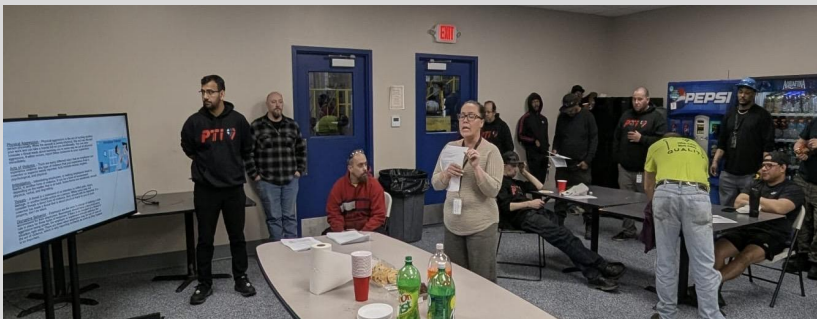


### Masking

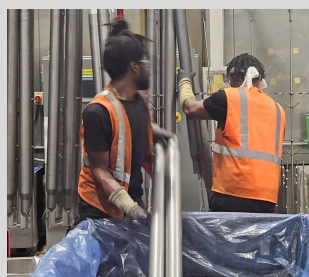

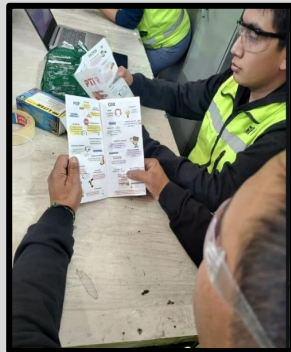
### They Strengthen Measures to Prevent Safety Risks

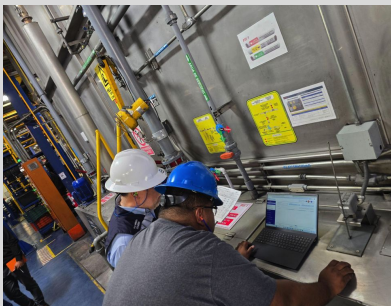

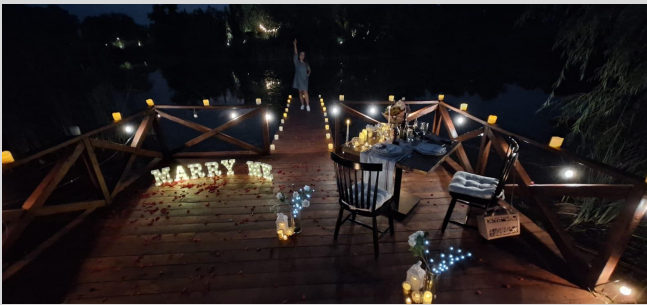
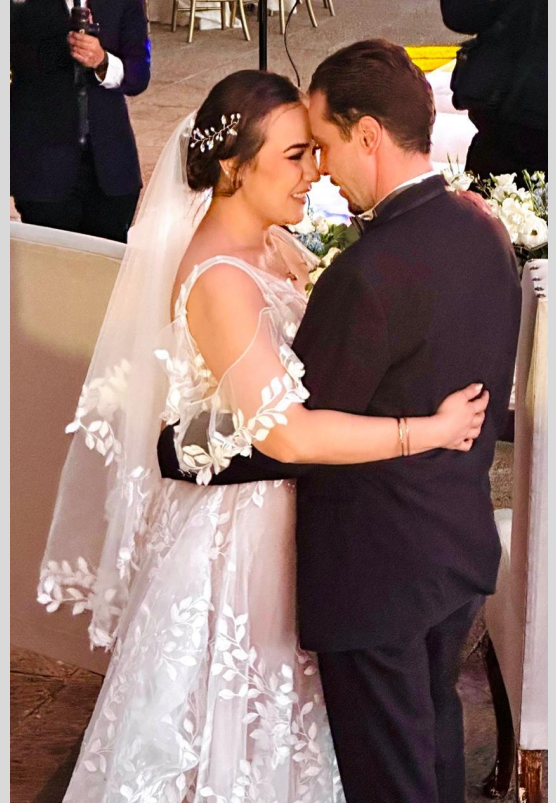
## Our Paint Operations Manager Got Married

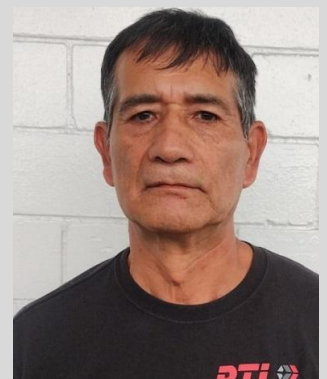
